STRATEGIC THEME: Workforce: Respond to community and workforce needs by developing a culture of agility

REPORT: The proposed 92-credit Honda PACT AAS degree is designed to prepare students for entry as a Honda-specific automotive mechanic across the Portland-Metro area. The Honda PACT program shares the first year with our existing automotive maintenance program, and students then specialize the following year.

RECOMMENDATION: That the College be authorized to submit an application to the Higher Education Coordinating Commission for the Honda PACT AAS degree for Portland Community College.
